



G.A. McLauchlan Co-Curricular Excellence Scholarship

This Scholarship has been provided by Grant McLauchlan, OBHS Old Boy 1980-1984 and Managing Director of CrestClean. The Scholarship is given to students who distinguish themselves through both their academic achievements and their active participation in school life. These students rank in the top 20% academically, but their contributions extend beyond the classroom. Whether they are involved in sports, the arts, leadership roles, or community service, they exemplify the values of commitment, balance, and leadership. This award recognises not only their hard work in their studies but also their dedication to making our school a vibrant, engaged community. The Otago Boys' High School Foundation is pleased to be associated with the award of this scholarship.

Terms of Scholarship

- Amount: \$1,000 per recipient for one year.
- One award per year group annually (Years 10-12).
- Eligibility Criteria: Top 20% academic result in the year group, demonstrated involvement in extracurricular interests at school and/or in the community, and an overall positive contribution to School life and to leadership.
- Applicants cannot concurrently hold another scholarship.
- Application can be made in successive years.

Application Process

- Applicants must apply by the published deadline each year, usually late in Term 3, using the Google Form.
- At the beginning of Term 4 eligibility will be verified using academic results, sports registration and other extracurricular participation.

Scholarship Award

- The scholarship will be awarded to one year 11 and one Year 12 student at the Senior Prizegiving each year, and to one Year 10 student at the Junior Prizegiving each year.
- The scholarship will be a cash award provided to the successful applicant after the commencement of the following academic year at OBHS.

Scholarship Funding

- Committed funding for a minimum of 12 years, from 2024 to 2036.
